CHLORINE STABILISER



HSNO Classifications – 6.3B, 6.4A

Not classified as Dangerous Goods

Cyanuric Acid CAS NO – 108-80-5

FIRST AID – If medical advice is needed, have product container, label or SDS at hand. **IF ON SKIN** (or hair): Wash with plenty of soap and water. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. If irritation occurs, seek medical advice/attention. **IF IN EYES** – Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes; Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Immediately call a Poison Centre or Doctor/Physician. **IF SWALLOWED** – Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Seek immediate medical attention. **IF INHALED** – Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If you feel unwell seek medical attention. National Poisons Centre – 0800 764 766 **IN EMERGENCY** – Ring 111 then ask for ambulance for medical help or fire for major spills.

DIRECTION FOR SUNSCREEN

Use to stabilise and protect your pool chlorine from bright sunlight. Saves your pool chlorine and helps produce more consistent chlorine levels in your pool. Note: If you are using Pool-Treat Maxi-Tabs, use only half the recommended dosage.

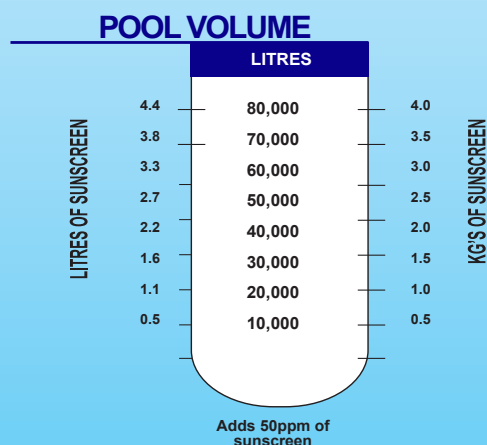
TO DISSOLVE: Pour into a nylon stocking or muslin cloth and place in or near the skimmer.

IDEAL RANGE: All Pools 30 to 80 ppm Cyanuric Acid.

WARNING Causes mild skin and eye irritation. Wash all parts of the body thoroughly after handling. Wear protective gloves/clothing, eye/face protection. In case of fire: Use large quantities of water to extinguish. If spillage occurs: Ensure appropriate protective equipment is worn (gloves, overalls, respirator, safety shield, boots). Keep combustibles and incompatible materials (as described in SDS) away from spilled material. With a clean, dry shovel, place material into clearly labelled containers and seal for disposal. Following collection of spilled material, rinse area with copious amounts of water. Keep waste away from drains, sewer and waterways. Consult local waste authorities for appropriate disposal methods.
